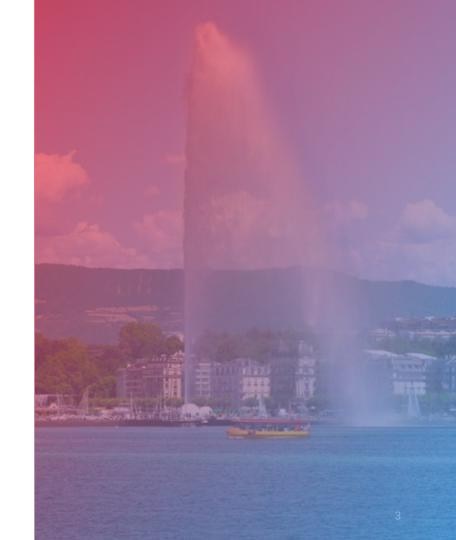

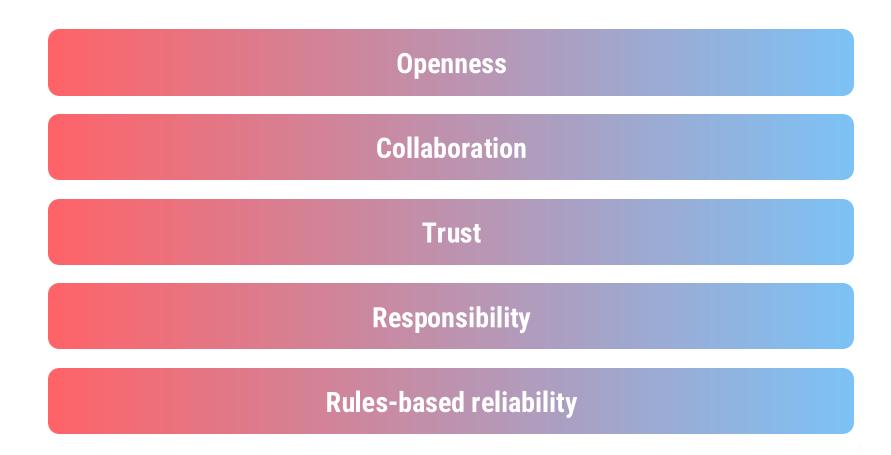

1.1 Context: The time is now

- As opposed to many other countries, Switzerland is lacking a strategy for what to achieve and how to use AI.
- Switzerland must find its AI position to make a difference in the global AI ecosystem - one based on Swiss values such as openness, collaboration and trust.
- Switzerland has national lighthouse projects such as ALPS, but needs to define priorities and coordinate stakeholders to realize full impact on competitiveness and digital sovereignty/self-determination.

Digital Infrastructure

e.q make e-ID a success; invest in design, control and safety (cyber) of swiss digital infrastructure as a backbone for critical infrastructures; Use cross-sector synergies;

Al Ready Data

e.g encourage public sector to generate high quality, up to date and linkable datasets as a basis for Al; ensure data safety and security

Al Governance

e.g smart governance: blueprint for the private sector, sector-specific self-commitments (e.g. media)

- To provide a platform for Swiss and Switzerlandbased companies that embody Swiss values



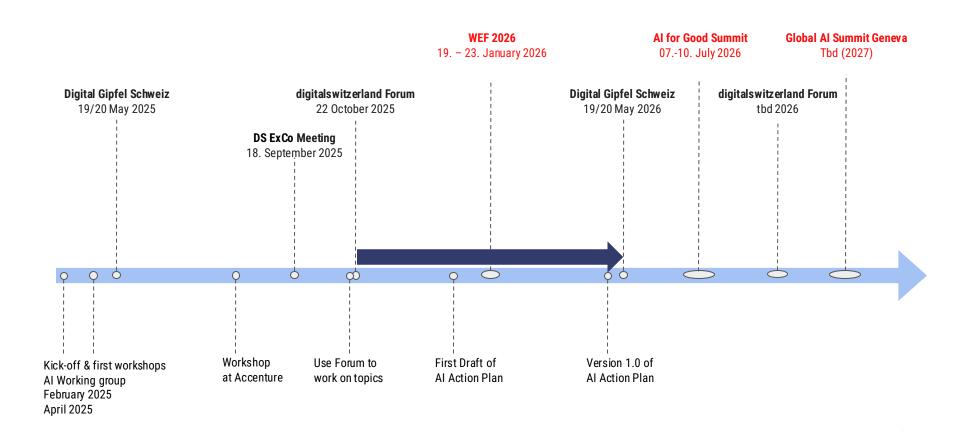
